A statement signed by parent or guardian must request leader dispensing of medications rather than camp management. See bottom statement on permission slip.

Closed Toed Shoes are required by the camp. Crocs are acceptable. We recommend socks to be worn with all shoe types (even if going to the shower or waterfront).
